> MAKE YOUR OWN EASY ACCENTS

Inexpensive glass paint in vibrant hues turns simple vessels into pretty vases especially when displayed against a stained-glass window. Brush paint onto bottle exteriors, using long, even strokes. We stopped at one coat for a translucent effect; for more intense colour, apply a second. Allow the vases to dry completely before using. Citrus fruit motifs adorn this stunning duvet, lending whimsy to a mostly neutral space. With its rich colours and hand-drawn effect, the pattern, based on an archival design by architect losef Frank, feels charming and welcoming - and it's so eye-catching there's no real need for a headboard. Mismatched side tables feel unified thanks to their dark hues, while natural textures abound. Pillows and a throw in lemony tones play up the effect.
